

Familiarisation Programme for Independent Directors

(I) Details of Familiarisation Programme:

(1) Formal letters of appointment have been issued to the Independent Directors which, inter alia, incorporates their roles, duties and responsibilities. In addition, the Company has provided copies of Code of Conduct for Members of the Board of Directors and Sr. Executives, Whistle Blower Policy, Terms of Reference of the respective Committees of the Board and also other regulatory updates/policy framework from time to time.
